#### **Review of Past Events**

- Peter Piper Pizza (Back to School Night) The school raised \$682, which is significantly lower than previous years. It is also worth noting, the Yearbook party in May 2025 was also significantly lower. Fundraising VP is looking for, and open to, suggestions for a venue for future Yearbook Parties and Back to School Nights.
- Frios Pop day (August 27) made \$65. Due to low numbers, the PTA will not be continuing with this fundraiser.

# **Upcoming Events**

- Grandparent's Breakfast will be tomorrow, September 5 at 7:00 AM. Since we are unable to set up the tables this evening, the PTA is requesting volunteers arrive at 6:00 AM. Extra signage has been made to remind grandparents to stay with their grandchildren until 7:45 am, when the school is officially open.
- Diamondbacks Day is on September 21, Canyon Rim PTA receives \$5 per ticket sold and has made \$445, so far.

- Autumn at the Rim is October 17 (5 PM 8 PM). This will be in place of our spring carnival, Cougarnival.
  - Due to increased feedback of conflicting schedules in the Spring, the carnival has been moved to the fall and will be more of a traditional fall festival.
  - The fall festival will also be combined with Teach or Treat (which will run from 5 PM to 7 PM).
  - Ticket prices are still undetermined at this time, but will follow the traditional Cougarnival selling timeline with a pre-sale offered weeks before the event and will be less expensive than Cougarnival wristbands.
  - A wristband only needs to be purchased for children, adults do not need wristbands.
  - While the planning committee is still working on small games & activities, the swing ride, fiberglass slide, and two inflatables have been booked. The PTA has also booked Creature Kingdom, in lieu of the petting zoo and a photo booth.
  - There will be a reading corner, that will also act as a sensory area for overstimulated children, which will also satisfy family engagement for Title I. Teachers, staff, and others who would like will be asked to volunteer to read stories to children.
  - Kids will be wearing costumes
  - There will be no silent auction
  - The PTA discussed the option of adding a "donate a wristband" option in Givebacks to allow families to donate to others that might not be able to afford their own wristbands.

## **Board Reports**

- Membership: 93 Members
  - This reflects a 2.2% increase year-to-date and 74% of our 2025-2026 Membership goal.
- Fundraising:
  - The PTA has launched a Magic Story fundraiser. Families can create children's books with a cartoon image of their children. This is ongoing all year, but will be advertised more around Christmas.
  - In lieu of Butterbraid and Cookie Dough, Our fall fundraiser will be Popcorn, which will run from November 10th through the 25th. The Canyon Rim PTA will receive \$7.50 for every tin sold (tins cost \$15).

- Boosterthon has been booked for February
- Marketing: Nothing at this time

     Conference night. Still considering Schlotsky's Deli or Jimmie John's for the entire staff meal.

  - The bank account was reconciled and verified. No big income or expense items this month.

  - The price for Money Minder (software used by the PTA treasurer)
    has increased. Motion to amend the PTA 2025-2026 Budget line
    item Reflections from \$300 to \$198.59 and move that \$101.41 to
    Money Minder line item increasing it from \$200 to \$301.41 made by
    Jen Packer. Motion passes.
  - Motion to amend the PTA 2025-2026 Budget by removing the Reflections line item and transferring the remaining \$198.59 to General purchases made by Jen Packer. Motion passes

#### **PTA Business**

- Motion to use PTA gift card to compensate babysitter for watching children during meeting made by Bonni Beveridge. Motion Passes.
- Motion to Approve Amendment to Standing Rules
- Motion to amend the Standing Rules regarding Debit and Credit Card Use made by Danielle Biela. The amendment states:
  - Debit card purchases must be within budget and pre-approved using the Debit Card Purchase Form by two bank signers who are not the card user.
  - Remove the requirement that purchases "must be pre-approved by the Executive Board."

- Remove the Debit Card Purchase Form requirement: "Form must be completed and signed by the President and either the Vice President or the Treasurer."
- Remove all references to "Credit Card," as the PTA does not have one.

 Motion to amend Standing Rules. Amendment is a grammatical error where one sentence was cut into two bullet points made by Sam Thurber. Motion Passes.
